Halloween is just around the corner and students are excited for their first holiday party of the year. Classroom parties are scheduled for Tuesday, October 31st.

PARADE:

Weather permitting, we will be having an outdoor parade beginning at 1:40 PM. If weather does not allow for us to parade outdoors, we will create an indoor parade route. Parents are welcome to attend the parade! Please find a grassy area to stand as students will parade on the sidewalk all around the building.

COSTUMES:

Costumes should not be worn to school and should be easy to put on without assistance. Costumes should be able to go directly over clothes. No makeup, hairspray/paint, or weapons will be allowed with any costume. Costumes are optional and students who do not wish to wear costumes are still welcome to participate in the parade and party.

CELEBRATION:

Pizza will be provided for students to eat in their classrooms. Lead parents and parent volunteers should have party plans and activities (party in a box) ready for students.
